

RUSA Player Travel Rules

General Rules:

RUSA has a Zero Tolerance Policy toward drug and alcohol use. Any player found with drugs and / or alcohol or believed to be using drugs and / or alcohol will be sent home at the parent's expense. The player will be expelled from RUSA.

Please be sure to have your coach's cell # in your phone in case of an emergency. Also please keep RUSA Directors (Scott Baker 561-504-8327), and Justin Abbey (302-218-3782) in your phone for emergency contacts.

Players are to stay with their teams the entire time. There will be no time spent away from the team with family, visiting friends, etc. This is a team event and not a family vacation.

Players must drive at all times in their designated vehicle. Players are not allowed to drive with their parents, family, and / or friends. Exceptions may be made for medical attention.

There is to be no contact with boyfriends and / or girlfriends during the tournament. Boyfriends and / or girlfriends should be discouraged from attending. However, if they do attend they are only permitted to watch the game from the sideline. There should be no interaction with players at anytime, including but not limited to: the team hotel, parking lots, restaurants, or anywhere else the team may be.

Air Travel:

Please be sure to arrive at the airport at the designated time with your bags clearly marked with your name and information.

Be sure to be dressed in ONLY RUSA apparel that is designated by your coach.

Remain with your team during check in and only go through security with your Coach or Team Manager. When using restroom or getting food go with someone and make sure your Coach knows.

Make sure all liquids larger than 3.4 oz are in your checked bag.

Please do not leave your bags unattended at any time.

Please take your assigned seat quickly when boarding the plane. If you would like to switch seats please wait until after the seatbelt sign is turned off during the flight.

Remember that we will never be the only ones on a flight. Please be aware others on the flight.

Make sure you check your area and have all your property before departing the flight. After departing do not leave the gate area. Wait for your Coach. Always keep an eye out for your team and club mates.

Hotel:

Under no circumstance is anyone to leave the hotel property without your Coach or Team Manager.

Never invite any non - RUSA FC players or staff into your room.

Do not prop hotel doors open for any reason. This is a serious security issue.

Remember different teams have different schedules and there may be other guests around you as well, please be quiet and courteous ESPECIALLY during early morning hours when you may be leaving for an early game.

Please do not walk throughout the hotel barefoot.

Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.

Any player caught outside their room after the set curfew will receive serious repercussions including possible suspension or expulsion from RUSA FC.

Once room assignments are made by your coach changes cannot be made without approval of your coach. It is very important that an accurate rooming list is maintained for emergency purposes.





The coach reserves the right to have a key to the player's room to use for curfew checks. For Girls' teams with a male coach, a team Mom would be assigned for room checks.

Soccer balls are not to be kicked in the room or halls. Do not run or talk loudly in the halls - you will disturb other hotel guests who are paying for a quiet room and do not want to hear noisy soccer players. Joy riding in elevators and roaming the hallways is not acceptable.

No charges (including telephone or pay-per-view movies) to a team room are allowed unless there is prior approval by your coach.

Be sure to check your rooms thoroughly before checking out and to leave your rooms in excellent condition.
